F. JPA BUSINESS

1. Employee COVID-19 Surveillance Testing

President Rory Livingston stated these conversations started a couple months ago with the idea of looking solely at employee surveillance testing and what was going to be required to reopen schools. That is where it was left after last month's meeting with everyone thinking about it and having pros and cons.

Rory stated that December 30, 2020 the Governor came out with his plan on Safe Schools for All and how we are going to reopen and test employees and students. Rory stated this is a huge game changer and changes the conversation we had prior. He stated he thinks MERMA should walk away from this or at least take a pause. At no time did we ever consider testing of students and we now have a governor who has thrown that into the ring. He stated he doesn't feel this is something viable that MERMA as a workers' compensation program should involve itself in running a testing program. If testing of students doesn't survive then we could always revisit it when it hits final form of what Safe Schools for All is going to look like.

Yvonne Perez stated she would like to see MERMA pay for the potential cost of employee testing but doesn't think it is viable for paying for student testing.

Veronica Flournoy stated the initial conversations in terms of bringing MERMA into this was so the districts would have a reporting mechanism to get the information as employees are tested as well as having a common program for all districts to follow. There was never an intent to include the requirement of student testing. She stated she agrees with Yvonne and that it would be nice to have MERMA involved so that we could still retain the reporting end of it.

Rory stated there is so much that is going to change between now and whatever system comes into play. When something is finally finalized then we can revisit the conversation. He stated it would be inappropriate for us to take a position or even commit ourselves into doing something when we don't know what that is going to be. Veronica Flournoy agreed that it is impossible for us to make commitments when the rules of the game keep changing.

Lengthy conversation was held.

It was discussed to reconvene with the Board of Directors once more information is available.
